Objectives in spending Sport Funding

To help the school:

- Provide an exciting P.E. Curriculum that ours pupils enjoy and that inspires all our pupils to achieve
- Inspire our children to participate in regular physical activity and competitive sport
- Instil in our pupils the spirit of sportsmanship - honesty, teamwork, respect, self-belief, passion and determination

Summary of spending & actions taken to be taken:

- £1350 allocated to continuous professional development with staff attending courses and taking part in team teaching activities to improve the standard of teaching and learning
- £350 was spent on new resources to encourage active lunchtimes
- £3024 to employ a sports coach to run specialist clubs at lunchtime and after school
- £2000 to employ a play coordinator at lunchtime to encourage children to participate in active games
- £1000 spent on an Early Years PE scheme and resources
- £350 for transport costs
