Class 2 Home Schooling Newsletter - 18th January 2021

Hi. I hope that you managed to complete some of the work and that you have enjoyed some of the activities. Thank you to those who have managed to email and upload some of the work it has great to see what you have been up to. I shall continue with the same format this week as it seemed to work well last week.

Thank you for the remote learning you are doing at home with your children. We recognise the extra strain this puts on families but we really appreciate you keeping the children, your family and us safe by staying at home and following the rules.

I have popped another video onto Purple Mash which explains what you will be doing this week. Have a look at it before you start.

There are 4 main lessons a day. I appreciate that this may be difficult to complete especially if you have more than one child at home or you are working at home alongside them but it would be really beneficial if they could complete the Phonics, English and Maths lessons as this will help them when they are finally able to return to school. If you can complete any of the other lessons then that is a bonus and I am sure the children will really enjoy them.

There will also be some work on Purple Mash including reading, maths games, this week's spellings and worksheets for some of the other lessons.

Don't forget there a variety of other activities online that you might want to use as well – Phonics Play, lettersandsounds.org, Teach your Monster to read (it is free on the website but not the app), Oxford Owl, Joe Wicks (Mon, Wed, Fri at 9am), Just Dance and Cosmic Yoga.

I am teaching full time so please bear with me, I will get back to you as soon as I can. In addition, if you wish me to give you a call to check in with you just drop me an email & I will endeavour to give you a call at some point during the week when I am not teaching.

You can also take photographs of work your children have done and email them to me or upload them onto Purple Mash and I can mark it there. I also think you can use the Notes App on an iPad to scan work and upload as well. I hope this helps. It is great to see what the children are doing.

This week it would be great if you could send me a piece of work that you and your child are really proud of. We are going to mount them on a jigsaw piece and make a class jigsaw with the pictures on a display board in the classroom. Once the jigsaw is complete I will upload a photograph of it onto Purple Mash so that you can all see the display and find your work on it.

We have some more exciting news as well. We will be celebrating National Handwriting Day on Friday 22nd January. We are holding a competition for the best piece of handwriting work. I have chosen a short poem below and I would like you to copy it in

your best handwriting. Please use all of the handwriting skills that we have been practising including starting each sentence with a capital letter (but remembering not to join the capital letter at the start), ending with a full stop, checking the formation of your letters, joining if you feel confident.

There will be a winner chosen from the children in school and a winner from the children who are working from home. We can't wait to see your amazing work! The winners will be announced on The Croft Primary School Facebook page and prizes will be handed out in school or delivered to your home.
