This week White Rose maths and Bitesize continue to look at fractions. I have attached the sheets to print off. They are focusing on: tenths as decimals, fractions on a numberline and fractions of a set of objects. This is great to do practically at home with a tube of smarties! You count the total of the smarties and put this on the bottom (your determiner) then you select a colour, count them and put that number of the top (your numerator) - this then tells you the fractions of the tube that is that colour.
