Key Learning: In this lesson the children will plan out the story of Hansel & Gretel on a 9 square board ready for their writing tomorrow. There is no

Thursday:

Friday:

Key Learning: Editing and Rewriting a fairy tale. In today's lesson I would like the children to look again at their writing from yesterday and edit it using the Success Criteria. Also check spellings and punctuation. I would then like the children to write up their final writing either by hand or typed and hand this copy in for me to mark and put up on our Hansel & Gretel writing display.

E.G. 5 Star jumps = 5 points, 20 star jumps = 20 points. Use the exercise sheet if you are unsure of what any of them are. This is a task just for you, and your challenge is to see if you can beat your score each time you do it.

You are not allowed to repeat an exercise and they all must be done within 20 minutes. Circle each activity as you complete it. Add your points up at the end and put them in the results sheet. Don't forget a short rest in between each and have a drink to hand and make sure you find a clear safe area to exercise in.
