Mathematics:

Mathematics lessons will continue to use the White Rose links This week the focus will be on multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 and 1000. Tuesday through to Thursday will have a linked video clip and a worksheet to complete.

Writing:

The focus of this week's writing lessons will be on the build up of skills that will help to construct a set of instructions on 'How To Care For Your Dragon' unit. Oak National Academy is delivered by practicing teachers who have been employed by the Government. It is a recommended site designed to support schools in the remote learning.

Reading:

I have set you the first 4 chapters of your new book, either 'Just the Beginning' or Magic Actors' or 'Sam and the Wet Day' depending on your reading level, followed by the accompanying multiple choice and associated questions in Purple Mash. If you log in and click on your 2Do's they should appear for you.

There are between 4 and 5 chapters to complete this week. The chapters will expire at the end of the week so try to complete by Friday. When you have completed all associated activities upload them for me to mark. Can I encourage children to try and use Friday to catch up with any SPAG, sequencing and open-ended questions they may not have completed throughout the week.
