As the children have learnt about the different food groups, they now need to look at the human body. They should learn about the skeleton and how different muscles work. I have attached on Purple Mash a cut and stick activity where

they label the skeleton. A great way to do this would be to draw around someone in your family on the ground or on a roll of wallpaper, and then label the different parts. I would love to see some of those pictures!!

STEM

Below I have attached a link for an investigation from STEM. This is a fantastic site that we use in schools and it links Design Technology with Science. If you're feeling adventurous then this would be a great way to explore how our skeletal structure protects our internal organs - you could even try it with an egg!
