In our **Phonics** lessons this week, we are learning to read and spell words ending in 's' including words with the diagraphs sh, th and ch.

In **English** this week, we will be continuing the story of 'The Three Little Pigs' with Miss Doherty. The children will be writing simple sentences and recycling the story by changing the characters and materials.

In **Maths** we will be continuing to count objects up to 10, finding 1 more and 1 less and ordering numbers to 10 with Miss Molnar.
