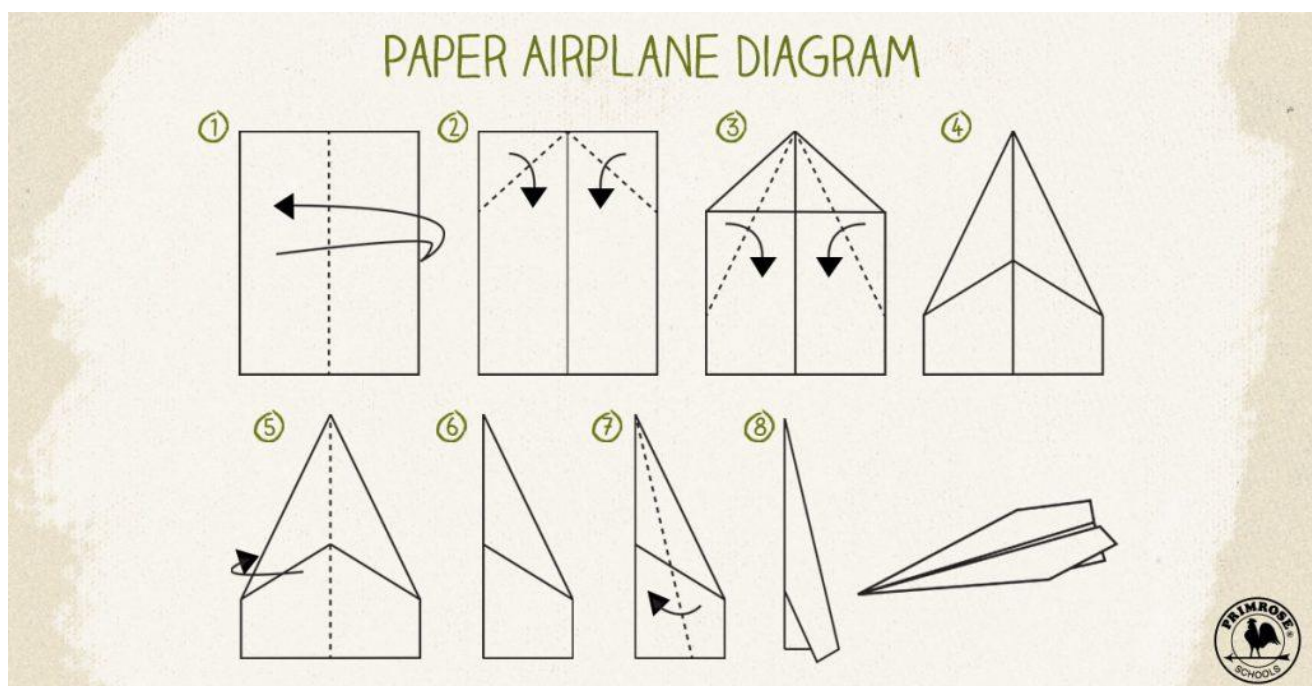
Tuesday

Topic - This week I want us to learn a bit more about flight. Thinking a bit more about aeroplanes - where they came from and who invented them. Once you have finished - have a go at making some paper Aeroplane - I have uploaded instructions onto Purple Mash too. Can you record some facts about The Wright Brothers onto your planes. Maybe you could make 3, write a new fact on each one, then fly them - which one flew the furthest?



Wednesday

There is lots of writing in this session - can I remind you to do what you can. It may be that if you are just learning to write in sentences you write 3 sentences. Handwriting - I would like the children to complete Unit 9 of their handwriting booklet today.

Topic - Have a look at The Wright Brothers - Orville Wright and Wilbur Wright. Can you draw a portrait of one of both of them. Follow this link to a You Tube video on how to draw a face. Thursday

Group 1 - **and, the, you, with**. I have uploaded a wordsearch for you to have a go at. The Look, Say, Cover, Write and Check sheets are on Purple Mash.

Group 2 - The sounds /f/, /l/, /s/, /z/ and /k/ spelt ff, ll, ss, zz and ck. The words are: **off, well, miss, buzz, back, shell, dress, puff, fizz, pack**. There is a quiz to have a go at on Purple Mash too. The Look, Say, Cover, Write and Check sheets are on Purple Mash.

You have 20 minutes to get as many points as you can by completing the exercises below. Each exercise is worth so many points, so the more you do of each, the more points its worth. E.G. 5 Star jumps = 5 points, 30 star jumps = 20 points. Use the exercise sheet if you are unsure of what any of them are. This is a task just for you, and your challenge is to see if you can beat your score each time you do it.

You are not allowed to repeat an exercise and they all must be done within 20 minutes. Circle each activity as you complete it. Add your points up at the end and put them in the results sheet. Don't forget a short rest in between each and have a drink to hand and make sure you find a clear safe area to exercise in.
